

2008 “Dorm-Storming” Regulations GW Housing Programs and the Residence Hall Associations

1. All candidates and affiliated individuals must comply with previously established GW Housing Programs rules and regulations.
2. Including him/herself, no candidate may authorize more than two individuals per night.
3. Candidates and authorized agents must register at the candidates meeting on February 12th for each and all nights that they wish to dorm storm.
4. The deadline for all changes to the initial registration is 1 day following the candidates meeting (Feb 13th), submitted to the RHA point of contact via email.
5. For UPD and GW Housing Programs purposes, all candidates must register in advance with the RHA Point of Contact. The following information MUST be provided:
 - Last Names
 - First Name
 - GWid
 - Student Organization
 - Whether the person is the candidate or a proxy
 - Email Address
6. Candidates and authorized agents will be provided with a badge for each night that they have registered. Badges will have the date and candidates name whom they are representing. After registration, candidates and authorized agents’ names will be provided to GWHP and UPD allowing them to be in the residence halls.
7. The following dates and time outline the dates allowed for in-dorm campaigning. If candidates, or authorized agents, are found campaigning outside of these times, it will be considered a violation of GWHP, JEC, and RHA guidelines.
 - Saturday, February 23: 2:00 – 6:00 p.m.
 - Sunday, February 24: 7:00 – 11:00 p.m.
 - Monday, February 25: 7:00 – 11:00 p.m.
 - Tuesday, February 26: 7:00 – 11:00 p.m.
8. The aforementioned dates are not hall-specific; candidates are free to campaign in dorms of their choosing in the allotted time, and can visit as many dorms as possible in the allotted times.
9. Candidates or authorized individuals intending to distribute campaign literature or items of any sort (e.g. posters, fliers, palm cards) in the residence halls must have already been submitted to the JEC.
10. Literature can only be distributed to students on a direct basis – i.e. any items must be handed to the students. Items cannot be slipped under doors, left in stairwells, etc.

12. All candidates and authorized individuals must wear his or her badge at all times during dorm-storming, and carry his or her GWorld during dorm-storming.
13. Candidates and authorized individuals may not knock on doors of residents who have identified themselves as not wishing to be disturbed.
